- 1. Remove the switch cover (four 10-24 UNC screws).
- Remove the two contact block retaining screws and withdraw the complete contact block.

NOTE: The arrangement of the latches and position plate on some switch types may make it difficult to remove the contact block. To make the job easier, you can relieve pressure between the contact faces by operating the switch mechanism.

- 3. Remove the socket head screw and withdraw the movable contact assembly. Remove the liner.
- Place the new liner over the movable contacts molding and press it into the switch body, making sure that the liner locates on the boss in the casting and does not impede the movement of the movable contact molding.
- 5. Remove the movable contacts and spring from the cage, and replace with new contacts and spring.
- Reassemble the movable contact assembly and screw it in place with the 8-32 UNC socket head screw, making sure that the nylon lock washer is fitted under the head of the screw.
- 7. Assemble the new contact block and screw it in place with two 8-32 UNC screws. Check operation and contact alignment.
- 8. Reassemble the cover using four 10-24 UNC screws.
